Guidelines for Abstract submission are listed below.

### Abstract to 18<sup>th</sup> IBC (IUPAB)

Each abstract should be in a Word file with no more than 250 words and should include only text (no figures, tables, references or citations). The text should be in single-column format, single-spaced, Times New Roman or similar at 12 pt font.

**Title of the abstract** (Boldface 14 pt, Flush left. Do not capitalize the title except the first letter).

**Authors:** (Times New Roman 10 pt, Italics). Family name should be placed after the first and middle name. <u>Underline the name of the presenting author</u>. Do not include the title of the authors (e.g. Prof., Dr., etc.).

Author Affiliation (include postal and email addresses, Times New Roman 10pt, Italics, Flush left).

Body of text (Times New Roman 12pt)
